Lawn edging - all you need to know



Most people know that a lawn needs regular watering, trimming, and mowing in order to keep it well maintained. Lawn edging, however, is commonly overlooked as a key maintenance task, when in fact, it is the perfect way to keep your garden in top shape.

Crisp, precise borders can be tricky to get right and maintain by hand, which is why edging strips can be incredibly useful. Whether you go for straight or curved lines, edging a lawn correctly will give your garden a neat and elegant look.

To mow or edge first?

Mowing and edging are integral to achieving a great garden, but which should be done first? Whilst there is no right order, most people would advise mowing first due to:

- Overgrown lawns and full of weeds - a thick layer of grass will make it harder to edge
- Lawn debris and thatch build up – cleaning up the bulk of the lawn makes it easier to see what you are doing for easier installation

When is the ideal time to edge your lawn?

There is no set time of year to edge your lawn, however there are a few things to take into consideration:

- The summer can be tricky as will be too dry and will be harder to push the edger into the ground
- Winter months will be problematic if there is frost, snow or frozen ground
- Therefore, it's advisable to edge your lawn in the spring season, where the climate and soil moisture levels will be best suited

What types of lawn edging do we have available?

EverEdge is engineered from 1.6 mm gauge galvanised mild steel whilst Rite-Edge is manufactured using aircraft grade aluminium; both coated with a corrosion-resistant paint finish. EverEdge utilises an interlocking system that requires the installer to push tabs from one piece into the next at the overlap, whereas Rite-Edge adjoins via a telescopic design which eliminates the need for connector pins/stakes. Irrigation

The practice of applying controlled amounts of water to land to help grow crops, landscape plants, and lawns



Tree watering bags

Biological controls

Biological controls in amenity settings

It is now widely established that nematodes can provide effective control of chafer grubs and leatherjackets in amenity grassland and managed amenity turf surfaces as part of an integrated pest management plan. This reduces direct damage caused by the larvae eating turf roots as well as indirect damage through predators disrupting the turf surface in search of food.

This natural, non-pesticidal approach to insect control can also be used on a variety of pest insects that affect amenity trees, shrubs and plants including caterpillars and vine weevil. In small numbers these insects may not be a problem but when populations build up, they can cause significant aesthetic damage and even affect the health and survival of the plants they feed upon. In addition, some caterpillars such as the oak processionary moth caterpillar can become a human health hazard due to the presence of hairs that can irritate skin and eyes.

Using nematodes to control caterpillars

Nematodes are particularly useful for controlling caterpillars that cluster together such as box tree moth, oak processionary moth, and tortrix moth caterpillars. They are most effective when used during the early life stages of the caterpillars. This has the added benefit of reducing plant damage and hazards to human health which are associated with later instars of oak processionary moth caterpillars.

To use, prepare a solution of water and nematodes then spray onto the foliage until the point of run off concentrating applications in known areas of caterpillar clusters. A spreading and wetting adjuvant such as Velocity will assist with spread of the nematodes, improving infection rate.

Using nematodes to control weevils

Vine weevils are a common insect which can cause considerable plant damage. Adult vine weevils will eat plant leaves, causing distinctive notching damage. But it is the larvae eating away at plant roots that is most damaging, potentially causing plants to wilt and die.

Vine weevil larvae can be effectively targeted by nematodes applied to the soil either as a drench or in irrigation or dosing units. They can be targeted year-round, whenever soil or growing media temperatures are $>16^{\circ}\text{C}$ (Larvanem) or $>10^{\circ}\text{C}$ (Entonem).

Grazing with livestock is an effective method of managing perennial wildflower meadows and grasslands because it creates uneven growth and distribution of species which leads to habitat niches. Grazing is also a good option in areas where it is difficult to utilise machinery, perhaps because it is too wet or because the ground is too rough.

Mowing and removing the clippings can be used to replicate the process of hay cutting and grazing. It is important to remove clippings to avoid nutrients being returned to the soil. Soils for wildflowers are usually low in nutrients to encourage species diversity.

Annual wildflower meadows

Cornfield annuals need disturbed ground to stimulate germination of fallen seed. After flowering leave plants long enough for seeds to drop. Preferably wait until the spring before cultivating the ground to avoid leaving bare soil over winter. Cultivating the soil may stimulate growth of fallen seed but it may be necessary to supplement with further sowing in subsequent years.
